**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At a total depth of 4184', water was encountered which rose 100' in 3 hours, and could not be bailed down. It proposed to plug this well as follows:

Fill up hole with rock about 10' and drive 700% of lead wool on top of rock. Run 2" tubing to bottom, circulate mud to surface and set a 10 sack cement plug above the lead wool. Tubing will then be raised to 3830', which is the base of salt, and a 10 sack cement plug placed there. Tubing would then be raised to 2290' and a 10 sack cement plug placed near the top of salt and extending up into 7" casing which was cemented at 2285' with 50 sacks.

7" casing will be knocked off and all possible salvaged, hole will be filled with mud to a depth of 300', where a bridge will be set, and 10 sack cement plug placed below the fresh water zone. Hole will then be filled to surface with mud and a marker erected. Hiss will be filled and grounds cleaned.
