DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At TD 3990' dolomite hole was cased and cement plugs were set from 3990 to 3900', from 3602 to 3521' and from 1955 to 1874' (Base Salt 3527' - Top salt 1960'). A 11 8 5/8-inch casing was pulled and 7 6' of 10 3/4-inch casing was pulled leaving 90' in hole. A 35' top plug was set in 10 3/8-inch casing to surface. Permanent marker has been set as required in Rule 202. Well permanently abandoned.
