Referring to the above case. This bond covered Brown
State #1 Well, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 22-Township 21S- 34E.

We understand that the well has been fully completed,
and we are endeavoring to secure cancellation evidence.
We took the matter up with Attorney Livingston and had
his reply under date of December 30, copy of which was
sent to you. This letter showed that Mr. Brown had
not properly abandoned his well.

We are now in receipt of the copy of letter that Mr.
Brown wrote our agent, Mr. J. S. Ward, at Artesia, un-
der date of December 6, stating that he has had the
cellar filled up, the slush pit covered, the fence
removed and marker placed thereon. He further stated
that he would make another check of the conditions at
this well and put it in proper shape.

We would appreciate your advising us in the enclosed

tion has been cleared and if you are in a position to
furnish the proper evidence to the Santa Fe office,
so that they can give us complete cancellation evidence.
