DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 7"OD 24# Casing at 3,617' and cemented with 200 sacks, casing was tested by bailing dry and a satisfactory shutoff was obtained. Well was carried to a total depth of 3,733', ground level, ran tubing and bottomed at 3,706', well flowed 212.52 bbls of oil in 4 hours thru 2" tubing, w/ Gas-Oil ratio 274/1.
