This form shall be executed and filed in QUADRUPLICATE with the District Office of the Cil Conservation. Commission; covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate contribute shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary change in the transporter involving les than the allowable production for one proration period, the operator shall in lieu of filing a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter o the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished such temperary transporter. Such tempolary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated a nount shown in suid notice.

This certicate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and authorization to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until

- (a) Operating ownership changes
 (a) The ransporter is changed or
 (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.
