Dear Commissioner:

The subject lease contains 40 acres in section 14 of the above indicated township which is dedicated to the Pure Oil Company, Wilson Deep Unit; 120 acres in section 23 of the same township which is dedicated to the Sinclair Oil and Gas Company, South Wilson Unit. Gas wells have been discovered and completed on both of the above units. The acreage in section 15 is undedicated.

This is to advise that Wilson Oil Company State B-9084 No. 25, originally completed as an oil well on January 25, 1948, has been plugged back and is producing commercial gas. The potential of the gas well is 780 mcf gas per day with a tubing pressure of 525 lbs. The gas will be used on leases in the Wilson Pool operated by the Wilson Oil Company for engine fuel and possible lift purposes at a later date. Thus the lease will be extended by continuous production of gas. Wilson Oil Company is attempting to obtain a gas market by the establishment of gas reserves in the area.
