Old total depth 3713'. Deepened to 3723'. On packer test, well showed only sulfur water. Deepened to 3774, set packer at 3768, tested oil with no water. Well has not been acidized or hydrofraced. Will be placed on pump. On swabbing gauge, well tested at the rate of 61 BOPD. Gas - oil ratio too small to measure.
