FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Prior to the shut in status of the above well in August 1951, it was producing 100% water. We therefore propose to plug and abandon our State P #2 as follows:

Shoot off and pull approximately 1100' of 7" casing. Spot 25 sack cement plugs as follows: In the bottom of 7" casing (3669'); in the stub of 7" casing (approximately 2100'). Spot 55 sack cement plug through the interval from 230' to 112' and a 25 sack cement plug to the surface. The intervals will be filled with a heavy mud.

The location will be levelled and a 4" abandonment marker erected in accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission regulations.
