In an attempt to increase production we propose the following:

Set bridge plug at approximately 3600', perforate 3525 - 3550 and 3560 - 3570 with four shots per foot, acidize with 500 gallons acid, followed with a 5000 gallon sand oil frac containing 0.1 pound of sand per gallon and flush with 50 barrels oil. Retest well and return to production.
