

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 7 at 8:00 a.m., 110 hours had elapsed since setting 3655' of 7" OD 20# SS Casing and cemented with 150 sacks to be used as oil string. At the time casing shut off was tested as follows:

The hole was bailed dry before and after drilling cement plug, allowing to stand one hour after each bailing. As casing shut off tested okeh, drilling operations were resumed.
