### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With T.D. at 3780, 43 gallons plastic were dumped on bottom on June 18, 1946, filling up 3783. Fluid level could not be lowered below 3600' by bailing. Dumped 85 gallons plastic on bottom June 17, 1946, and filled to 3775. Water was bailed, but water came in hole at rate of 6.5 barrels in 50 minutes indicating water not shut off. Plug has been drilled and well will be deepened to about 3335 to test for oil.
