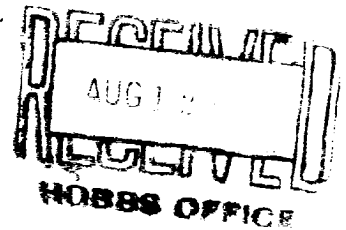

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 1, 1949, at 11:00 p.m. 48 hours had elapsed since running 1621' of 8 5/8" casing set at 1610' and cemented with 100 sacks to be used as intermediate string. Water shut off was tested by bailing hole dry and allowing one hour to elapse before testing for water leak. The above test was repeated after drilling plug. Both tests were successful. Drilling was resumed.
