Small amount of sulphur water encountered below 3892'.

We propose to set a cement plug of 15 sacks in bottom of hole then fill hole with heavy mud to bottom of anhydrite and set a 10 sack cement plug with bottom at 1800'

We will leave the 10 3/4" casing (cemented at 204') in the hole and fill hole with heavy mud, then set regulation marker at surface in cement
