T. 21S, R. 34E, West Funiice Field, in regard to pipe program.

According to our files you only have in this well one string of
7" casing set at 3726' with 300 sacks of cement. This does not
comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation
Commission and neither does it comply with the program stated on
your Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill.

In this district or any other district in Lea County the Rules and
Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission calls for a surface
string and an intermediate string of pipe, the surface string is to
protect the fresh water and the intermediate string to protect the
salt section.

On this well you have pulled all pipe except the 7" and it has been
cemented with only 300 sacks cement. I don't believe this is a
sufficient amount of cement to protect either the salt section or
the fresh water. I refer you to Order #52, Casing Program for the
Lea County Fields. I recommend that this 7" pipe be two staged
at the top of the anhydrite above the salt section and cemented back
to surface.
