On November 6 at 8:00 PM, 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 1857 feet of 9-5/8" 36# New Casing to be used for salt string in subject well. At this time, cement shut-off will be tested as follows:

A pressure of 800# will be built up and held for thirty minutes, and if casing tests OK, cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 800 again built up and held for thirty minutes. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
