Well No. B-1 in SW Quarter of Sec. 1, T. 21-S, R. 33-E,
N. M. P. M., Lynch Oil Field Oil Field Lee, County.
The plan outlined on Form SG..... was followed except:

The results were as follows: (Give details) Put in 1-1/2' feet rock and 2-1/2 feet
Lathe cuttings. Shot well with 120 quarts from 3757 to 3776 feet. Cleaned
out to bottom and drilled one foot of Lathe cuttings. Total depth of well
now 3778 feet. Apparently there was no increase in production. Pumping one
hour daily, 13 barrels of oil and no water.
