Following is a report giving the results of work done as indicated above at The Texas Company
Well No. B-1 in NW-1/4 of Sec. 1, T. 21-S, R. 33-E,
N. M. P. M., Lynch Oil Field Lea County.
The plan outlined on Form SG 104 was followed except: Was not altered.

The results were as follows: (Give details) We have plugged and abandoned well as follows: 10 sacks of cement was used to cement pay off. The hole was then filled back to 3612' with heavy laden mud where a 6-1/4" male and female wood plug was set. The 6-1/4" casing was parted at 2003'. Hole was filled with heavy laden mud to this point where 10 sacks of cement was placed. The hole was filled with heavy laden mud to 1674' where an 8-1/4" male and female wood plug was set, the 8-1/4" part at 1164' and pulled. 10 sacks cement placed at this point. 12-1/2" casing was parted at 687', hole filled with mud to this point and 10 sacks cement used. All 15-1/2" and 20" casing was pulled and
