NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

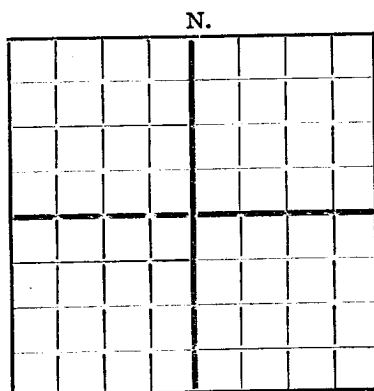
