NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon (Temporarily) Well
No. 2 in Lot 12 of Sec. I of Sec. _____, T. 21 S, R. 33 E,
N. M. P. M., Leon Oil Field, Leon County.
We plan to commence work on _____, 19____.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Well does not pay operating costs. Producing but 4 barrels oil with 125 barrels water.

The present condition of the well **before cementing:**

Total depth 3805' 6" with 8 1/4" casing set at 3473 ft. 8 1/4" hole to bottom.

To shut off the bottom hole water for the purpose of preventing infiltration to the oil pay, 40 sacks cement was put in with dump bailer. The top of the cement is 3767 ft. or 3 ft. above the first oil pay.

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:
