DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State # 2 well T.D. 3805'. Hole cemented back from 3805 to 3767'. shutting off pay. Hole filled with mud and 8-5/8" casing knocked off at 2418', pipe pulled. 10" casing Knocked off at 1020' and 10 sacks of cement run in top of 10" casing. Filled hole with mud to 400' and run 10 sacks of cement, filled hole to bottom of 20" casing set at 136', and run 10 sacks of cement. Palled 2 joints of 20" casing. Filled hole to surface and cemented 4" marker extending 4' above level of ground.

38'4" of 20" casing.
1020'6" of 10" casing.
2418'9" of 8-5/8" casing.

Casing left in hole.
97'9" of 20" casing.
51'5" of 15 1/2" casing.
413'1" of 12 1/2" casing.
