NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon State "B" Well
No. 3 in NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 2 Twp. 21-S Rge. 33-E
N. M. P. M., Lea Oil Field, Lea County.
We plan to commence work on 4-28-33, 1933.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Water encroachment in oil horizon

The present condition of the well is as follows:

3778-3874 Lead Plug, 3774-3765 Cement, Mudded to top.

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Plug solid with rock, steel cutting to 3740, dump cement to 3710, bail dry, mud to 3722, bridge with rock and steel cutting and dump 10 sacks cement, pull 8 1/2" Casing, mud to 1783, bridge with rock and steel cuttings and dump 10 sx cement. Pull 10" Casing, mud to 335, bridge and dump 10 sx cement, mud to 120' bridge and dump 25 sx. cement, fill with mud to top and cement cellar.
