Top of anhydrite 1680 ft. top of salt 1760 ft. base of salt 3530 ft.

No oil, gas or water, 8 5/8 pipe set at 1260, 10 3/4 pipe set at 660,

13 3/8 pipe set at 150 ft.

30 sacks of cement was pumped to bottom, hole was then filled to 1700 ft.

with gel, 30 sacks more cement was pumped in at 1700 ft. hole was then

filled with mud. All pipe in hole was then pulled. Bridge was set at 150 ft.

and hole was filled from 150 ft. to bottom of cellar with 200 sacks cement.

Four inch pipe was cemented in top.

This well was drilled with cable tools.
