Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Commission Order No. R-530 , which granted approval of an unorthodox gas proration unit of 320 acres for your Mexico "W" Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Please be advised that the above mentioned 320 acres has been assigned to your Mexico "W" Well No. 1 and No. 4 in the proportion of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit for each well, as requested in your application of June 28, 1955. Therefore Order No. R-540 and Order No. R-540-A is hereby cancelled effective the date of connection of your Well No. 1. On the date of connection of your Well No. 1, the allowable for your Well No. 4 will be reduced to 160 acres.
