Dear Pete:

At your request I am forwarding a copy of the original notice of connection on the Amerada Petroleum Corporation, State WLF No. 1-F gas well, Eumont gas pool.

As outlined to you in our conversation last week, we connected to the well and commenced producing gas on September 15, 1954. Then on October 5, 1954 the well was shut-in at Amerada's request, this due to the new Federal Power Commission rule.

On January 27, 1956 we received notice from Amerada that authority to produce the well had been granted, but due to mechanical difficulties the well was not back on production until February 10, 1956.

As Amerada had authority to produce the well and El Paso was already connected to it, it appears that the allowable should be made retroactive to at least January 27, 1956.

Should you need further information regarding this matter I shall be happy to assist you.
