Amerada State NE "F" Well No. 1,
Sunco-Monument Pool, Lea County,
New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

By copy of this letter Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation State NE "F" Well No. 1 located 3300' from the south line and 1980' from the west line of Section 1, T-21-S, R-35-E, was completed June 9, 1954, at a plugged back depth of 3845 feet. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well on the Amerada State NE "F" lease together with the location of all offset wells.

(b) That the subject well has 7" casing set at 4150 feet and cemented with 700 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the perforated interval of 3680 feet to 3720 feet, 3750 feet to 3760 feet, and 3790 feet to 3800 ft in the lower Seven Rivers formation, Sunco-Monument Pool.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

(1) Perforated the 7" casing in the interval of 3338 ft to 3370 ft, 3434 ft to 3480 ft and 3500 ft to 3560 ft in the middle Seven Rivers Formation.

(2) Set production type packer below these perforations at 3628 ft to separate the two pay zones.

(3) Produce the lower Seven Rivers oil through the tubing and the middle Seven Rivers gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

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
