
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

318' T.D. - Red Bed - Finished drilling 13-3/4" hole to 318' @ 5:15 P.M. 5-5-54. Ran a total of 7 jts of 9-5/8" OD Casing set @ 312' w/300 sacks of cement. Pumped plug to 280' @ 9 P.M., 5-5-54. Max Pressure 150#. Cement circulated WOC 12 hours. Tested 9-5/8" OD Casing w/1000# before and after drilling cement - OK. Drilled cement from 276' to 312' and circulated hole to bottom @ 318'. Started drilling formation and 8-3/4" hole from 318' @ 7 P.M., 5-6-54.
