DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled to a total depth of 3940'. Ran 125 joints of 5½" 14# J-55 casing, total 3932.24' set at 3939.74'. Used 5 centralizers. Halliburton cemented with 870 sacks of regular cement with 3% gel, 870 sacks of Diamix "A" with 1/2# of Flocele per sack followed with 200 sacks of regular neat cement. Plug down with 1400# at 5:35 AM 11-7-56. WOC for 24 hours. Ran Worth Well Service temperature survey. Top of cement was found at 1893'. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes OK.
