DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Oil string set at 3632, cemented with 100 sacks of cement.
Depth 3865, at which point got sulphur water. Plugged back to
3850 with lead wool. Got perfect shut off. Then filled with gravel up to
3815 and shot from 3815 up to 3780. Shot loaded with gravel up to 3770
and oil up to 3450. Shot with 190 quarts. Test shows increase to be 60
bbls..

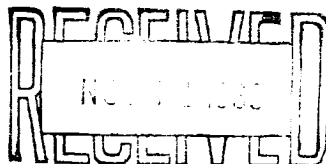
