Permission is requested to abandon the producing zone by setting cast iron bridge plug in 7" casing (set at 3648', cemented 200 sx). The casing, at this time, will not be pulled, but will be perforated at 900-50 and 1200-50' in an effort to obtain fresh water for drilling purposes. The final plugging will be submitted for your approval at the abandonment of the water zones. Wells drilled under identical circumstances and having 7" casing cemented with 200 sx, have found the top of cement at about 1500', which would be 100' above the top of anhydrite.
