Attached is form C-103, setting out the final plugging of the Wilson Oil Company #1 Cisco State, Sec. 8, T21S-R35E.

I would like to point out, that from our experience, the use of cement, hydromite and calseal in remedial work has proven to be of temporary value. The only plug which we have used and has given positive and permanent plugs, is lead wool. The purpose in using lead wool in the Cisco State was to assure ourselves that the well would be properly plugged. However, to conform with your requirements, we dumped five sacks of cement on top of said plug.
