DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was drilled to 3750' with rotary and casing was set at 3700' and cemented in accordance with C-101 filed August 20, 1952. We moved off rotary and installed cable tools. All mud was bailed from hole, plug drilled and well cleaned out to 3650'. Bailing showed hole to be completely dry indicating good cement job.
