NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

Additional information: This well is being drilled in unproven territory. Therefore in case the well fails to produce oil, it may be desired to complete as a gas well from a sand at 3329'. It was deemed advisable to cement the casing only as high as the gas sand. The 9-5/8" casing cemented at 2970 was cement up into the surface casing with 630 sacks of cement. 1200# pressure will be placed on the casing and retained for 30 min. to test the water shut-off.
