## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented off bottom water with 30 sacks, set a 10-sack cement plug 3400-3450. 7" OD casing was shot-off and 2780 ft. was recovered. Hole was filled with mud laden fluid, and a 10-sack cement plug was placed at top of salt section at 1750. Hole was filled with mud to surface and a 20-sack cement plug was placed in top of the 16" surface string with a 4" pipe marker extending 5' above ground level. Cellar and pits were filled, and the surrounding terrain restored to natural conditions.

# ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT
