## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The subject well was spudded January 27, 1945 and was carried to TD of 4016 in lime with cable tools. Sulphur water was encountered, and rose 1500' in hole during 24 hours, with no show of oil or gas.

We propose to abandon this well by plugging in the following manner; Cement off Bottom water with 30 sacks, fill hole with mud laden fluid, recover as much 7" Casing as possible which was set at 3705 w/ 75 sacks, then place a 10-sack cement plug in top of 7" left in hole or at base of salt at 3430; place another 10-sack cement plug above top of salt section at 1780. The 16" Surface Casing set at 122', cemented with 150 sacks will be left intact, the top 10' of which will be filled with cement. A 4" Pipe marker extending 5' above ground level will be set in cement, the cellar and mud pits will be filled and the surrounding terrain restored to natural conditions.
