DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On April 18, 1945 at 6:00 PM 168 hours had elapsed since setting 3705 feet of 7" OD 20# new seamless casing as oil string and cementing with 75 sacks. Casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A Halliburton pump truck was moved in and a pressure of 1200# built up and held for thirty minutes, and as shut-off was OK, cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1200# again built up and held for thirty minutes, as this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.
