DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 12 1/2-inch hole to 303 feet in red beds. Ran 9 joints (287.56 feet) 8 5/8-inch OD, 24-pound, J-55, seamless, 8-round thread, second hand casing with Texas Pattern shoe. Cemented casing at 301 feet with 300 sacks (1:1 cement and Halliburton Pozmix plus 2% bentonite). Stopped plug at 268 feet. Plug down at 3:15 AM, March 10, 1955. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and commenced drilling 7 7/8-inch hole ahead.
