Exception to the "no-flare order" embraced
in Order R-520 -- Bright & Schiff Superior
State Well No. 1, Location K, Section 25,
T-21-S, R-35-E, Eumont Extension Pool, Lea
County, New Mexico.

This firm hereby requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission accept this letter as application for exception to the "no-flare order" embraced in Order R-520 as it applies to the Bright & Schiff Superior State Well No. 1, K-25-21-35, Eumont Extension Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

We wish to respectfully point out to the Oil Conservation Commission that subject well is an outpost well to what was once the standing limits of the Eunice-Monument Oil Pool in the general area of Section 25, T-21-S, R-35-E. Our well is presently in a sparsely developed area on the west flank of the Eumont structure. This firm has contacted the known purchasers of casinghead gas in the Eunice area. Please refer to the correspondence attached hereto. The Permian Basin Pipeline Company stated that they do not gather low-pressure casinghead gas. El Paso referred us to the Phillips Petroleum Company. Phillips' answer to our request for a connection, which is negative at this time, may be seen in the letter addressed to the undersigned from this firm's district engineer in Midland, Mr. Hugh Mayer. The results of our conversations with Phillips can be summarized thusly: at the present time, Phillips is not in a position to gather gas in the immediate area of subject well, but they may be in a position to do so next year. Phillips' Midland office expects to hear from their office in Bartlesville regarding this subject and has advised that Bright & Schiff will receive a formal answer to its request from the Phillips Petroleum Company in the near future. We have not received their reply as yet; however, we will be happy to furnish your office with copies of all pertinent correspondence received hereafter from Phillips and any other gatherers we are able to contact.

The casinghead gas production vented to date from subject well is tabulated below for your review. You will please note that the volume under discussion is very small when it is considered that there are no low-pressure gathering lines in Section 25, T-21-S, R-35-E and that subject well is nearly a mile away from the nearest oil wells that possibly could be tied into a low-pressure gas gathering system.

*No gas was produced for a period of seven days in September during which time the well was converted to pumping status.
