Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to Order R-553, No-Flare Order, as it pertains to Gulf's H. T. Grewitt "F" Well No. 1 and in support thereof, states the following facts:

The H. T. Grewitt "F" No. 1 is located 330 feet from the North and East lines of Section 25, T21S, R39E, Lea County, New Mexico, and was completed as an oil well in the vertical limits of the Eminent Pool on May 13, 1954. On completion tests, the well flowed at a rate of 120 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 933 cubic feet per barrel.

The well will not produce at sufficient pressure to enable the delivery of gas into a high pressure gas transmission line. The nearest low pressure gas gathering system is approximately one-half mile from the well; and at the present time, it is not economically feasible to deliver the gas from this well into this low pressure gas gathering system.

In view of the foregoing, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its Order R-553, No-Flare Order, as it pertains to a volume of approximately 36 MCF of casinghead gas which will be vented daily from Gulf's H. T. Grewitt "F" Well No. 1. This office will keep the Commission informed as to the outcome of attempts to provide a means for utilizing the gas from this well.

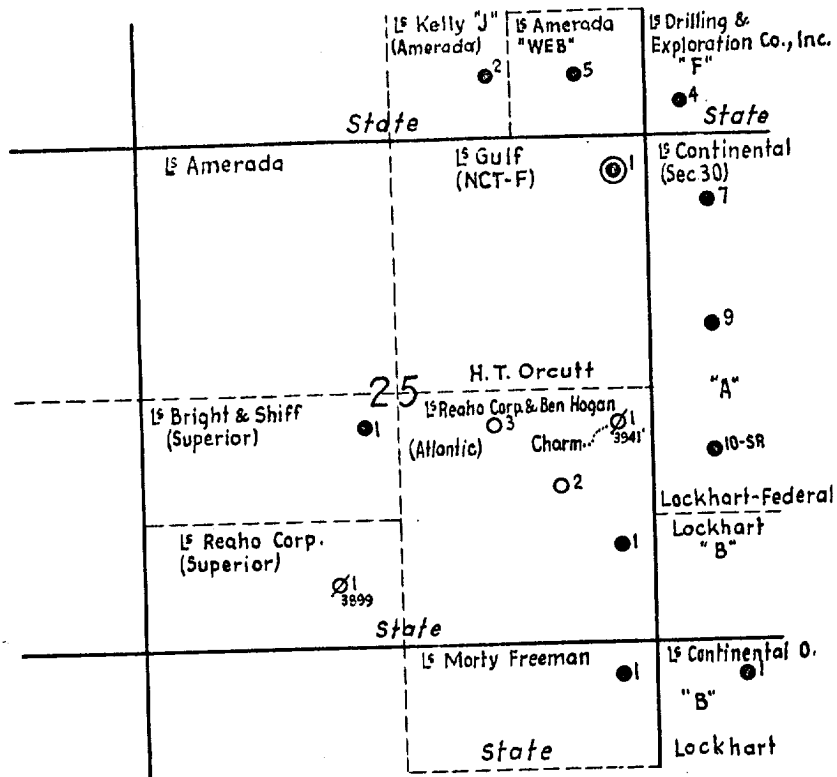
