## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total Depth 3952; 5½" casing cemented at 3507 with 350 sacks cement.

Top Anhydrite 1731'; Base Salt 3410; Well completed in 1949.

Well will produce no oil and only a negligible amount of gas.

Propose to knock off and recover all the 5½" casing possible (estimated at 500-1200 feet); then fill the casing with mud to the point where it is knocked off; then spot a cement plug of 15 sacks cement; then mud to a point 5' below the surface; then fill the hole to surface with cement.

The location will be cleaned and the surface leveled.
