Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 3 of the "General Rules and Regulations for the Prorated Gas Pools of Southeastern New Mexico" contained in Order No. N-1470 for a non-standard location for its State F-1 Well No. 1, located 500 feet from the south and west lines of Section 1, T-21S, R-36E, Eumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

This well was drilled and completed on May 3, 1938, as a gas well in the Grayburg formation. It was plugged back and re-completed in the Eumont Gas Pool on January 14, 1951.

It is proposed to allocate to the well a standard gas proration unit consisting of Lots 9 through 16, both inclusive, and 3/2 of Lot 17, T-21S, R-36E.

The provisions of the said Rule 3 have been met as follows:

1. The necessity for the non-standard location is occasioned by the completion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

2. The portions of proration located 100 to 1980 feet of said well have this day been furnished to the applicable authority by registered mail.
