DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "G" No. 2 was sand fraced with 10,000 gallon of oil and 10,000 pound of sand, casing pressure 1150#, tubing pressure 4200# rate, 11.6 barrel per minute. The well was swabbed, tubing and packer pulled and 30' of sand was cleaned out from 3812-42'. The tubing and rods were run and clean-out rig was released. The well was put on production and all load was recovered. After being thoroughly cleaned up the well produced 36.25 barrel of oil, 82.21 barrel of water in 24 hours. GOR was 1550. The well was pumped 14-36" strokes per minute.
