Under the provisions of Commission Order No. R-520, Rules 3 and 5(b), delegating the Secretary of the Commission authority to grant exceptions to the requirements of Rule No. 2 and No. 5(a) without notice and hearing for an unorthodox location and non-standard gas proration unit, respectively, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company hereby applies for an exception to the aforementioned two rules for State "C" Tract 11 No. 1, Eumont Field.

In support of the above application, the following data are furnished:

State "C" Tract 11 Nc. 1 is located 660' from the South line and 660' from the East line of Section 2, T-21-S, E-36-E. It was originally completed on November 1, 1937, as a Eunice oil well for an initial potential of 108 BOPD from interval 3667-3854 opposite the Grayburg formation. It was temporarily abandoned in October, 1947, after failure to respond to various stimulation attempts and declining to below 2 BOPD. Additional repair work ending January 3, 1954, failed to restore commercial production. Application to plug and abandon the oil zone and recomplete the well for gas in the Sumont Field was made by NMOCC Form C-103, dated January 7, 1954, and was approved January 12, 1954.
