FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Subject well was drilled to a TD of 3854 and completed on 10-28-37 after acidizing with 4000 gallons of acid. It flowed 12 BO in two hours and died. Pumping unit was installed and 108 barrels of fluid per day was pumped with 8' BS&W on the initial test. Production declined and in August, 1939, well was shot with 515 quarts of SNG and cleaned out to total depth. Since 1945 this well has been averaging about 12 BO per day on test. On a test on 7-3-47, well pumped 1.38 BO, 1 BW in 16 hours with an estimated GOR of 305. As well is unprofitable to operate, we propose to temporarily abandon by shutting in.
