Gentlemen:

We have received your C-101 form (Notice of Intention to Drill) dated October 26, 1950, which you have re-titled 'Notice of Intention to Recomplete' and upon which you have set forth your plans for working over your Akens No. 1 well in the south half of Sec. 3, T. 21S, R. 36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

On the plat on the C-101 form you have indicated that workover operations are also contemplated for succeeding Akens wells 2 through 6, also in 3-21S-36E. Our files show that we have C-101 forms on these wells dating back to the original drilling. We believe that for your present work-over operations it would be more proper for you to file a C-102 form showing intention to work over, and then a subsequent C-103 as a follow-up. Actually there should be only one C-101 form on each well, and we have tried to make the C-102 and C-103 forms sufficiently flexible to permit adequate reporting of all later work performed on the well.

We are therefore returning your C-101 form and trust that this suggested method of reporting your work-over operations will be satisfactory. If you need any blank forms, we will be glad to forward a supply.
