NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. It is desirable that a copy of this notice be submitted to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. Submit this notice in triplicate.

I am hereby giving notice that I intend to test the water shut-off in Well No. 1 in Sec. 34, T. 1 N., R. 10 E., Coconino County, Arizona, on February 10, 1933, at a depth of 300 feet. The method used in placing the test is as follows: Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 100 feet and then the test will be run. I have been advised that the test will be run at 100 feet.
