DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Killed well with water, made Halliburton caliper survey of hole, ran tubing with Guiberson Cakum Spiral Packer, set packer at 3802/08 and treated packer with 200 gallons of packer seal. Swabbed well in and cleaned until Dec. 14. On Dec. 14, 1945, tested well - flowed 100.22 bbls. oil, 33.41 bbls. water, 24 hrs, 36/64" choke, TP 65#, CP 0#, with a gas-oil ratio of 2891 cu. ft. per bbl. Prior to packer setting, well was flowing with a gas-oil ratio of 13046/1.
