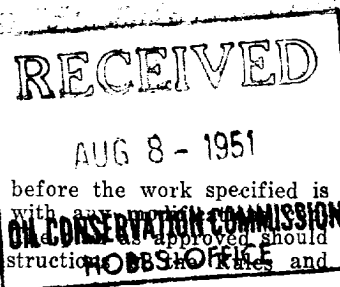

Well now producing approx. 1.50 bbls. oil daily from open hole 3750/3834. 5 1/2" OD casing is cemented at 3728 ft. We propose to pull rods and tubing run electric log to TD, and if gas pay present we will set retainer at 3700' and squeeze open hole with 100 sacks cement, then perforate the gas zones expected between 2999 ft and 3424 ft., acidize with 1000 gal. acid and complete as a gas well.
