

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's A. E. Meyer B-4 No. 7 well as described above.

Continental further requests that the 160-acre unit assigned to its A. E. Meyer B-4 No. 6 under the provisions of Order No. NSP-122 be cancelled upon approval of this proposed proration unit inasmuch as that acreage is included in the proposed unit. Well No. 6, to which the 160-acre unit is assigned, will be shut-in.




