Request for Non-Standard Proration Unit - Meyer B-4 No. 14, Unit Letter G, 5,940' FSL and 1980' FEL of Section 4, T 21-S, R36-E, Lea County, New Mexico

Conoco Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of a 160 acre non-standard proration unit for its Meyer B-4 No. 14 well. The well previously was given a 360 acre non-standard unit by Commission Order R-5055, however, well number 14 is not able to efficiently drain all existing reserves and can not produce the maximum allowable. Well number 15 will, by way of a recompletion to the Eumont Queen Gas Pool, make up the production that number 14 can not provide.

The proposed unit will conform to regulatory requirements in the following ways:

- The unit will consist of contiguous quarter quarter sections (and/or lots).
- (2) The unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (3) The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- (4) The length of the unit does not exceed 5,780 feet.
- (5) Copies of this application have been furnished by certified mail to all offset operators and all operators within the Section.
