Request for Non-Standard Proration Unit - Amended Acreage Dedication - Meyer  
B-4 No. 15, Lea County, New Mexico

Conoco Inc. originally requested by letter dated August 13, 1980 a 200 acre non-standard proration unit for the subject well. We now find that it will not be necessary to dedicate an entire 200 acres to this well and request that we be allowed to amend the dedication to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, T-21S, R-36E. The acreage will then comprise a 160 acre non-standard proration unit as shown on the attached acreage plat.

The proposed unit will conform to regulatory requirements in the following ways:

- (1) Said unit will consist of contiguous quarter - quarter sections (and/or lots).
- (2) Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (3) The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- (4) The length of the unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- (5) Copies of this application have been furnished by certified mail to all operators.

The acreage previously dedicated to Meyer B-4 No. 14 will be reduced accordingly by administrative approval.
